West Coast Nationals stirs up evening excitement

TULARE, Calif.— The 2007 West Coast Nationals Power Pulling Series (WCN) will begin Feb. 10 at the Elks/Unocal Event Center and Rodeo Grounds in Santa Maria, Calif., followed by the final competition in Tulare, Feb. 13 and 14, at the Tulare County Fairgrounds.

The final two nights of the 2007 Series will be held in conjunction with the World Ag Expo. The series champions will be named on Wednesday, Feb. 14. The outstanding lineup of high-powered tractors and four-wheel drive trucks will be a highlight of Expo's 40th anniversary celebration.

"The competition is really gaining momentum as we move into the third year," said West Coast Nationals Series liaison, Rob Fletcher. "The series will surely be an exciting event full of unpredictable, edge-of-your-seat entertainment!"

Pullers will converge in Tulare from all over the country, and possibly Germany and Denmark. The Santa Maria competition is Feb. 10, at the Elks/Unocal Event Center and Rodeo Grounds. Gates open at 10 a.m. with local events getting under way at 11 a.m. The main event starts at 1 p.m.

Tulare will host the Power Pulling Series on Tuesday, Feb. 13, with the series finals on Wednesday, Feb. 14 at the Tulare County Fairgrounds. Gates open at 4:30 p.m. with the main event at 6 p.m. both days.
